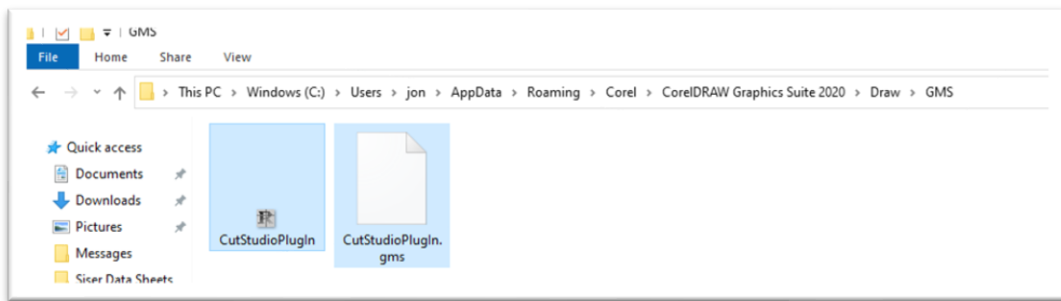
Adding Corel Plugin



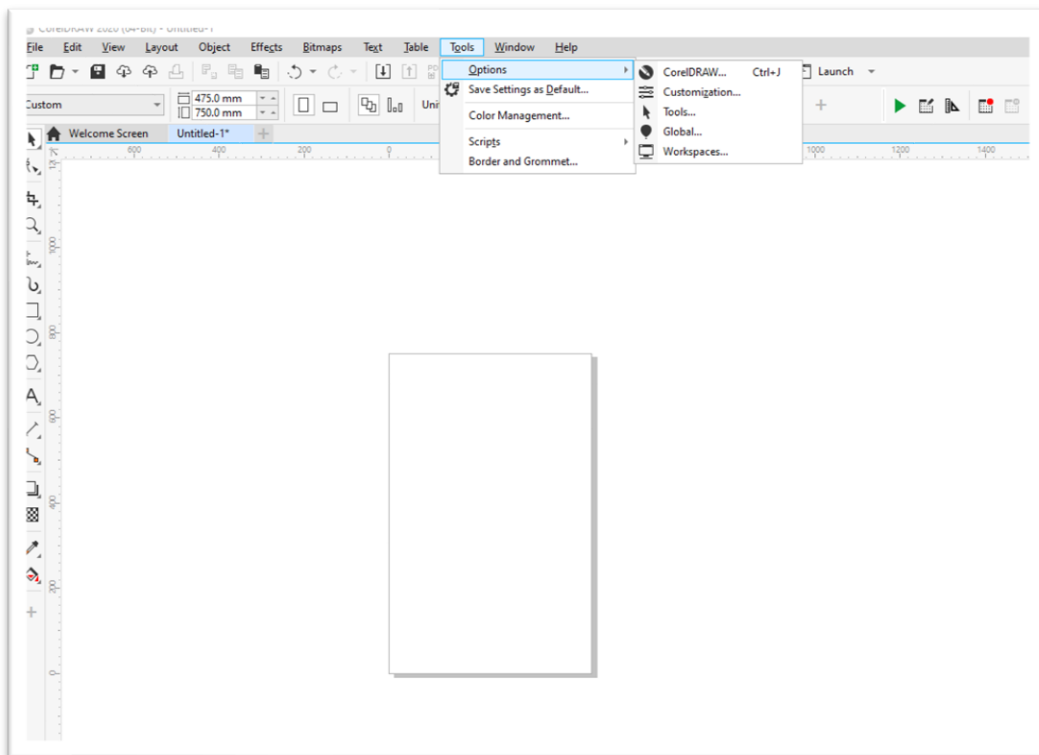
1. Download the Corel Plugin from;
<https://downloadcenter.rolanddg.com/GS-24>
2. Open the downloaded zip and extract the file. Copy the downloaded CutStudio .gms and .ico files to the following folder;

*This PC > Windows (c:) > Users > [USER] > AppData > Roaming > CorelDRAW Graphics Suite 2020 > Draw > GMS**

*If this GMS folder doesn't exist, please create it.



Open Corel and select the top menu; Tools – Options – Customisation.

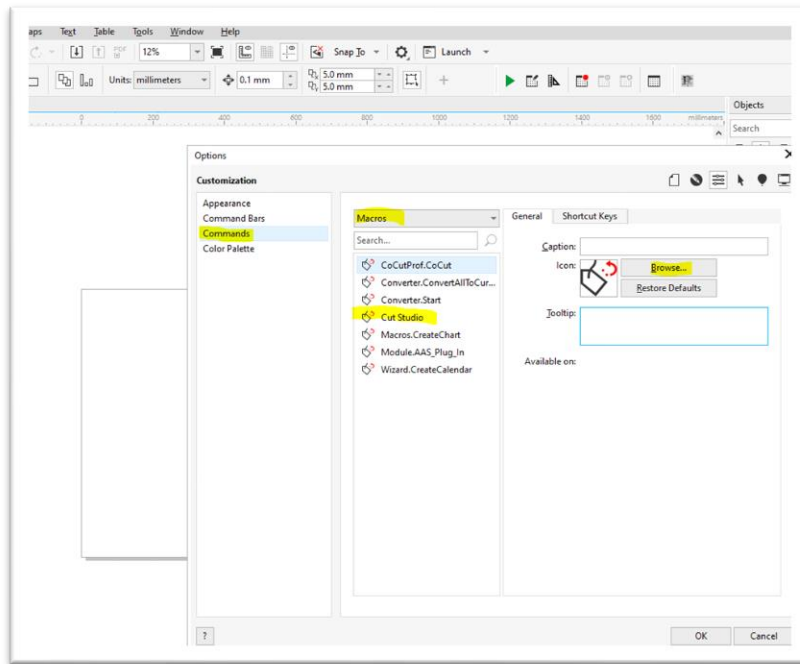


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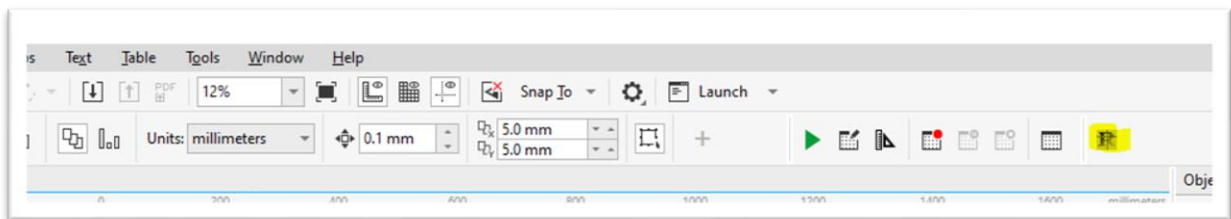
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3. Under Commands – select the drop down and change to Macros and Select the CutStudio macro.
4. Change the Caption to Cutstudio, and change/browse to the CutStudio Icon file (.ico).



5. Once the icon has been saved, click, and drag it on to the toolbar for quicker use.



6. Now when you select a design/text/logo and click the CutStudio Icon, it will import directly into CutStudio, measurement as per defined in Corel.

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
